Thank you for your interest in applying for the position of Class teacher at one of our Bushey Primary Education Federation Schools. We are a small federation comprising Bushey & Oxhey Infant School and Bushey Manor Junior School. Both schools are successful, two-form entry settings, currently sitting on strongly good Ofsted judgements.

We are looking for a class teacher who has a passion for teaching and learning and has an interest in curriculum design and delivery. There is a flexibility in this role to determine which of the two schools you would wish to be initially based, but as federated schools we can offer you opportunities to work thereafter across all primary key stages.

Our schools are constantly seeking to improve, develop and achieve ever higher standards for our children and staff. We are committed to continuing professional development and the federation offers support for our staff to grow by investing in middle leader training and senior leader development, such as through NPQML and NPQSL as well as through staff CPD, designed and led by all our curriculum leaders.
