Job Purpose:

To support a safe, inclusive, and enjoyable lunchtime experience for pupils by leading and supervising play and activities, encouraging positive behaviour, and ensuring the well-being of all children during the lunch break which forms 20% of the day.

Key Responsibilities:

- Supervise children during the lunchtime period in the playground and/or indoor areas.
- Organise and lead age-appropriate play activities that promote cooperation, creativity, and physical activity.
- Encourage inclusive play and ensure all children are engaged and involved.
- Promote and model positive behaviour in line with the school's behaviour policy.
- Monitor the safety of the play environment and report hazards or incidents as required.
- Set out and pack away equipment
- Liaise with the Headteacher about resources and the popularity of activities
