Pay Grade: HB

Purpose of the Role: To ensure the safety and wellbeing of pupils during the lunch period

Responsibilities:

- Prepare tables in preparation for lunch
- Supervise the pupils when they are in the dining room eating lunch, encouraging good social skills and manners
- Clear up the dining room after the lunch break including clearing any food and wrapping left on the tables, wiping the tables and benches and stacking benches.
- Supervise activities and maintain the health, safety, welfare, good conduct and safeguarding of pupils during the midday break, having regard to special or additional needs.
- Manage behaviour and encourage appropriate play
- Setting out and storing equipment
- Encourage pupils to select and eat healthy balanced meals
- Provide a safe environment for pupils to play/socialize outside
- Encourage children to be resilient and independent and follow the values and rules of their school
- Ensure the behaviour system is followed and deal with incidents accordingly. Report to senior staff in line with the school's behaviour policy
- Carry out any intimate care needs that arise. See the appropriate policy.
- Provide first aid during the lunch period as required
