Core Purpose

To assist with the smooth running of lunchtimes at Victoria CE School. Lunchtimes may be spent supervising children eating and playing in Nursery, in the dining room or on the playground.

Main Responsibilities

- To supervise pupils, during the lunch period, in the dining room, playground areas and school premises
- To monitor the behaviour of pupils
- To ensure the safety and well-being of all pupils, providing emotional support where necessary
- To ensure that all pupils who suffer any injury or accident are dealt with appropriately in accordance with the school's agreed procedure
