West Herts Community Free School Trust (WHCFST) is a new and innovative multi-academy trust of three free schools in West Hertfordshire which opened in brand new buildings in September 2014.

Two of the schools are in Watford and one in Hemel Hempstead. The trust is made up of people with a common and driving purpose who believe strongly that good academic and social achievement are a child's key to a successful future and choices about adult life. The trust board is a mixture of educational professionals and partner institutions including the University of Hertfordshire and each school has a local governing body.

Our main aims are to improve the lives of local children and families and to rank amongst the highest performing schools both locally and nationally. All our children know when they enter school that they are on the road to college, university or a good job and the nature of education in the schools leads to impeccable learning behaviours and exceptional achievement. Our schools are inclusive and welcome all from the local community including those with special needs.

We believe that a strong foundation in literacy and mathematics is crucial. Partly for this reason but also to develop confident learners with the right skills we have classes of twenty in reception and year one.

Our schools are still growing with the opportunity for staff to influence the future as well gain excellent professional development across the trust. We want to attract both new and experienced teachers. We grow leaders – many of our young staff have already developed and now hold middle or senior leadership posts as well as new professional qualifications.
