Parmiter's is a partially selective 11-18 co-educational school of 1456 students, including 411 in the Sixth Form. Academic results are consistently strong and we remain the most heavily oversubscribed school in Hertfordshire. At our most recent Ofsted inspection we were rated "an outstanding school with an outstanding Sixth Form". As a large secondary Academy we have many opportunities for both teaching and support staff.



Situated on an extensive 60-acre rural site in North Watford, Parmiter's has excellent links to the nearby M1 and M25 motorways. We are fortunate to receive financial support from Parmiter's Foundation which owns the school and its site and continues to invest substantially in its development.
