Appointment of Class Teacher at Bowmansgreen Primary School

Thank you for expressing an interest in the class teacher position at Bowmansgreen Primary School. We are a large, happy, two form entry primary school situated in the village of London Colney. Everyone involved in our school works hard to keep the children safe and to give them the very best opportunities possible. We are looking for someone to join the existing team to work in partnership with all stakeholders so that the needs of our pupils are met successfully.

Within our school we work hard to promote the Bowmansgreen values of kindness, respect, friendship, courage, determination, truth, honesty and trust so that everyone feels valued and part of our special community. Both the staff and children are very proud of our school and Ofsted (November 2019) celebrated our cohesive team of governors and staff who share the vision that every pupil will achieve their full potential. The Inspectors also recognised that teachers ask effective questions using subject specific vocabulary and that we cater well for our disadvantaged pupils. This is reflected in the children's attitude to learning – they enjoy coming to school, work hard and benefit from positive relationships with their teachers and nurturing classroom environments which promote good achievement. We are very fortunate that we have supportive staff and governors who are keen to support the work we do in school and we also have strong links with neighbouring schools. Our school has extensive grounds which we use for learning and Forest school activities and the children love helping to look after our school dog, chickens, rabbits and guinea pigs. Bowmansgreen Primary is easily accessible from the M25 and A414 and close to local amenities.
