Working at St John's Catholic Primary School

St John's is a 4-11 co-educational Catholic Voluntary Academy of 210 pupils and part of the All Saints Catholic Academy Trust (ASCAT). Academic results are consistently high and the school is one of several successful schools in the local area. Ofsted (March 2016) judged the school to be good in all areas and our last Diocesan inspection confirmed that the Catholic life of the school is outstanding.

An attractive and easily accessible location in south west Hertfordshire

Situated in Mill End, Rickmansworth, on an attractive site, the school lies just within the M25 motorway and close to Junction 17. The school is only a 15 minute walk from Rickmansworth station which is served by the Chiltern overground line (Aylesbury-Marylebone) and the Metropolitan underground line (Amersham - Aldgate).

A strong ethos with clear vision and values

The ethos of St John's is epitomised by the school's mission statement – 'Learning and Living God's Truth in Love'. Pupils and staff commit to the acts of love, service, respect, justice and faith.
