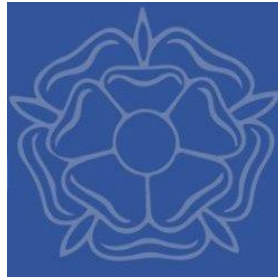


Tudor Primary School
