Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

The EYFS sets standards for the learning, development and care of children from birth to 5 years old. At Playschool Nursery, we promote a natural and stimulating environment both inside and out to allow the children the time to explore the world around them at their own pace.

The curriculum is delivered using a mixture of child-initiated play and adult led activities. Active learning takes place because play is purposeful, and children are engaged. We plan for children as individuals ensuring activities are tailored to their interests, style of learning and level of development. Effective practice in the EYFS is built on four guiding themes:

- A Unique Child
- Positive Relationships
- Enabling Environments
- Learning and Development

This approach ensures the EYFS meets the aims of improving outcomes and reflects every child's right to grow up safe, healthy, enjoying and achieving, making a positive contribution, and with economic wellbeing.



Facilities
